ORDER AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF PETITION

On December 20, 1938 petitioner filed an application for leave to amend the petition in the above proceeding in certain respects set forth in detail in said application. The record shows that on January 6, 1939 the application for leave to amend was personally served upon counsel for each of the owners and claimants named in the original petition and in the order to show cause issued on June 20, 1938.

At the hearing of January 11, 1939 counsel for petitioner moved that amendment of the petition be authorized. In reply to such motion, counsel for the owners and claimants stated that there was no objection to the proposed amendments as such, subject, however, to all of the objections made in the return to the order to show cause and during the argument thereon. The Commission having considered said application and motion, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Sacramento Municipal Utility District be and it is hereby authorized to amend Application No. 21960, and said petition is hereby amended in the manner and to the extent specified and requested in said application for leave to amend, a certified copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND PETITION

The petition of Sacramento Municipal Utility District, a municipal utility district, respectfully shows that:

I.

On the 20th day of May, 1938, the Board of Directors of said District did, at a meeting of said Board, by its Resolution No. 806, which was duly passed by unanimous vote of all of the members of said Board, determine that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition by said District under eminent domain proceedings, certain rights, lands and other properties as therein described for public use by said District in connection with the operation and maintenance of an electric system and works for the distribution of electric energy.

Said resolution did direct the bringing of appropriate eminent domain proceedings and specifically directed the filing of a petition before the Railroad Commission of the State of California, pursuant to Section 47(b) of the Public Utilities Act.

II.

On the 21st day of May, 1938, said District did, pursuant to said Resolution No. 806, file a petition with the

Railroad Commission of the State of California, praying said Commission to fix and determine the just compensation to be paid for an electric distribution system, existing within and adjacent to the boundaries of said District. Said petition was assigned application number 21,960 by said Commission.

III.

On the 15th day of December, 1938, the Board of Directors of said District did, at a meeting of said Board, by its Resolution No. 842, which was duly passed by unanimous vote of all members of said Board, amend said Resolution No. 806 by amending in certain respects the form of petition to be filed before the Railroad Commission, and directed the filing of this application for leave to amend said petition so filed on May 21, 1938.

IV.

The amendments for which authorization is hereinbelow prayed will, if authorized, amend said petition in the same respect and manner that said Resolution No. 842 did amend the form of petition set forth in and provided for by said Resolution No. 806.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the honorable Railroad Commission of the State of California, authorize said District to amend said petition as follows:

I.

Lines 15 to 17, inclusive, of page 4, of Exhibit A to said Potition, be amended to read as follows:

"Meters - includes all electric meters and any and all electric measuring devices (including instrument transformers, current, potential, and/or other), meter boxes, meter cans, meter seals and hardware.

(See <u>Customer Meter</u>. See <u>Transformers</u>)"

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II. 1 Between lines 30 and 31, of page 4, of Exhibit A to 2 said petition, the following to be inserted: 3 "Overhead Conductors - The term "overhead conductors" 4 refers to any and all electric conductors described as being 5 part of the properties which the District seeks to acquire and 6 which are not underground conductors as defined hereinafter in 7 this sub-item. S (See Electric Conductors. See Underground Conductors)" 9 III. 10 Lines 31 to 32, inclusive, of page 5, of Exhibit A to 11 said petition be amended to read as follows: 12 "Transformers - includes transformers other than 13 instrument transformers, current, potential and/or other, and 14 includes any and all transformer hooks, transformer oil and 15 hardware. (See Moters)". 16 IV. 17 Between lines 32 and 33, of page 5, of Exhibit A to 18 said petition, the following to be inserted: 19 "Transformer Leads - Refers to any electric conductors 20 which are electrically connected to any terminal on a transformer 21 22 and which extend from the inside to the outside of a transformer case and which extend from such terminals to the first point at 23 which said conductors are spliced or are in any other way electri-24 cally connected to other conductors." 25 ٧. 26 Between lines 33 and 34 of page 5, of Exhibit A to 27 said petition, the following to be inserted: 28 29 "Underground Conductors - The term "Underground conductors" refers to any and all electric conductors which are 30 described as being a part of the property which the District 31 32 seeks to acquire and which extend underground from manhole to

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manhole, or which extend from manhole to the pothead or condulet at the top of any riser which is not in a building or underground from the conductors above referred to in this definition to and into any building.

(See Electric Conductors. See Overhead Conductors)."

VI.

Following line 43 of page 5, of Exhibit A to said petition, the following to be inserted:

"Weatherproofing - The term "weatherproofing" when used herein with reference to conductors, refers only to that type of insulation which is used on weatherproof wire."

VII.

Lines 22 to 34, inclusive, of page 30, of Exhibit A to said petition, be amended to read as follows:

"EXCEPTING, FURTHER, any interest whatsoever in: (a) any buildings or other structures situate on either of those parcels of real property described hereinbefore in Sub-items 3.1 and 3.3; (b) any building or buildings other than any building or buildings in which there is a transformer or transformers to the low voltage side of which transformer or transformers are attached conductors through which (or through the extensions, or continuations of, or the electrical connections to such conductors) electric energy is conveyed to any customer meter, and other than any building or buildings situated on any parcel or parcels of real property described in Item 2 of this Exhibit "A" as being a part or parts of the property the District seeks to acquire; provided, that under this sub-heading (b) there are not included with any building or buildings excepted from the properties which the District seeks to acquire, any clamps, insulators, brackets, or other such devices (not including conduit) by means of which any conductors or the extensions, continuations or electrical connections to such conductors, any of

which the District seeks to acquire, are attached to such excepted building or buildings, it being intended that the District seeks to acquire all such clamps, insulators, brackets and other such devices; (c) any building, or buildings in which there is any fixture, or fixtures which the District does not seek to acquire; (d) those buildings which are indicated hereinafter in sub-items 4.53 and 4.54."

VIII,

Line 37 of page 36 to line 29 of page 37, inclusive, of Exhibit A to said petition, be amended to read as follows:

"Sub-Item 4.20 Further Exception of Electric

Conductors and Equipment Beyond Indicated Points.

"Paragraph 4.20.1 - Any electric conductors, or the extensions or continuations of, or electrical connections to such conductors, any of which are underground conductors, <u>beyond</u> any of the following designated points:

- "(a) If there is no transformer electrically connected to such conductors between any point where they enter into or pass under any exterior wall or bulkhead of any building other than any building located on real property specifically described in Item 2 or Item 3 of this Exhibit A, and a customer meter, the designated point is any point at which such conductors enter into or pass under any exterior wall or bulkhead (whichever is first) of any building other than any building located on real property specifically described in Item 2 or Item 3 of this Exhibit A;
- "(b) If there is a transformer or transformers electrically connected to such conductors, between any point where such conductors enter into or pass under any exterior wall or bulkhead of any such building, and any customer moter, the designated point is: If there is but one such trans-

former, any point where the transformer leads on the low voltage side of such transformers are electrically connected to the conductors which extend to any customer meter, or if there are two or more such transformers, any point where the conductors which extend between any terminals on the low voltage side of any two or more of such transformers are electrically connected to conductors which extend to any customer meter;

"PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in no event are there to be included with the properties which the District seeks to acquire any conductors or the extensions, continuations, or electrical connections to such conductors beyond any customer meter;

"PROVIDED, FURTHER, that all such customer meters are specifically included with the property which the District seeks to acquire whether such meters are located at or beyond the point to which said conductors or the extensions or continuations of, or electrical connections to such conductors are included with the properties which the District seeks to acquire.

"PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the word "beyond" as used in this Paragraph 4.20.1 means beyond the point indicated when going from the source of power towards any customer meter.

"Paragraph 4.20.2 - Any electric conductors, or the extensions or continuations of, or electrical connections to such conductors, any of which are overhead conductors, beyond any of the following designated points:

"(a) If (1) they are not in conduit, and if (2) they are within ten feet of any building other than any building situate on any parcel of real property described hereinbefore in Item 2 or Item 3, as measured along such conductors from any point at which they are attached to any such building, the designated point is the first point (when going from the source of power towards a customer

meter) in such conductors where they are covered with any insulating material other than weatherproofing;

"(b) If (l) they extend wholly or partially through conduit which is attached to or extends into any building other than any building situate on any parcel of real property described hereinbefore in Item 2 or Item 3, from conductors which extend overhead from pole to pole, or from pole to structure, or from structure to structure, on the one hand, to any building other than any building situated on any parcel of real property described hereinbefore in Item 2 or Item 3, on the other hand, and if (2) there is no transformer electrically connected to such conductors between the last point where such conductors are either covered with no insulation or are covered with weatherproofing, and a customer meter, the designated point is the first point (when going from the source of power towards a customer meter) in such conductors where they are covered with any insulating material other than weatherproofing;

"(c) If (1) they extend wholly or partially through conduit which is attached to or extends into any building other than any building situate on any parcel of real property described hereinbefore in Item 2 or Item 3, from conductors which extend overhead from pole to pole, or from pole to structure, or from structure to structure, on the one hand, to any building other than any building situate on any parcel of real property described hereinbefore in Item 2 or Item 3, on the other hand, and if (2) there is a transformer or transformers electrically connected to such conductors between the <u>last point</u> (when going from the source of power towards any customer meter) where such conductors are either covered with no insulation or are covered with weatherproofing, and any customer meter,

the point designated is: If there is but one such transformer, any point where the transformer leads on the low voltage side of such transformer are electrically connected to the conductors which extend to any customer meter, or if there are two or more such transformers, any point where the conductors which extend between any terminals on the low voltage side of any two or more of such transformers are electrically connected to conductors which extend to any customer meter;

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"PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the District seeks to acquire such conductors and/or the extensions and continuations of, and/or electrical connections to such conductors into, through and beyond any building or buildings (other than any building or buildings in which there is any fixture or fixtures which the District does not seek to acquire), in which there is a transformer or transformers, to the low voltage side of which transformer or transformers are attached conductors through which (or through the extensions, continuations or electrical connections to such conductors) electric energy is conveyed to any customer meter;

"PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that in no event are there to be included with the properties which the District seeks to acquire any conductors or the extensions, continuations or electrical connections to such conductors beyond any customer meter;

"PROVIDED, FURTHER, that all such customer meters are specifically included with the property which the District seeks to acquire whether such meters are located at or beyond any point to which said conductors or the extensions or continuations of, or electrical connections to such conductors are included with the properties which the District seeks to acquire;

"PROVIDED, FURTHER, that the word "beyond", as used in this Paragraph 4.20.2 means beyond the point indicated when
