In the matter of the application of Pacific Electric Railway Company for authority to discontinue non-agency stations at Lamanda Park Junction and Vinedo on its Sierra Madre Line.) Application No. 22500.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Applicant alleges that no freight business has been transacted at its non-agency stations of Lamanda Park Junction and Vinedo during the past twelve months and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary. Applicant also alleges that the Lamanda Park non-agency station is carried as a branch line point in its tariffs and that this situation should be corrected by publishing carload switching limits for Lamanda Park which will include the present station at Lamanda Park Junction.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Lamanda Park Junction and Vinedo, Los Angeles County, to eliminate said names from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations. Applicant is also authorized to include Lamanda Park Junction within the switching limits of Lamanda Park.

Within thirty days after effecting the changes authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This Order shall be effective immediately.
