INTERIM ORDER

Pacific Motor Trucking Company has requested authority to establish a temporary pickup and delivery service of property in the custody of Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency Incorporated, at Southern Pacific Company's station at Paso Robles, California. Applicant alleges that an emergency exists by reason of the expiration of the permit of the carrier who has been performing local pickup and delivery service under contract for applicant in Paso Robles; that said carrier does not intend to renew said permit; that by reason of such circumstances applicant will be unable to provide a pickup and delivery service; and, further that by reason of such circumstances an emergency now exists.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Motor Trucking Company is hereby authorized to perform a pickup and delivery service at Paso Robles, California, of property in the custody of Southern Pacific Company and Railway Express Agency Incorporated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire upon the effective date of a decision to be rendered

by the Commission on Application No. 18881, on a rehearing authorized by an order of the Commission dated July 18, 1938, or upon further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
