FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing therefor:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph six (6) of the Order in Decision No. 31355 dated October 13, 1938, reading-

" If the Pacific Gas and Electric Company acquires the plants, properties and assets of Midland Counties Public Service Corporation, it shall file with the Commission, unless otherwise directed by the Commission, monthly reports showing by accounts its operating electric revenues and expenses, including depreciation, taxes and uncollectible revenues applicable to the area now served by Midland Counties Public Service Corporation and the gross and net cost of additions and betterments to its electric property in said area,"

be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read-

If the Pacific Gas and Electric Company acquires the plants, properties and assets of Midland Counties Public Service Corporation, it shall file with the Commission, unless otherwise directed by the Commission, monthly reports showing by accounts its operating electric revenues and expenses, including depreciation, taxes and uncollectible revenues applicable to the area now served by Midland Counties Public Service Corporation and annual reports of the gross and net cost of additions and betterments to its electric property in said area, provided such data may be consolidated with similar reports required by Decision No. 31354 as amended for the electric department of the San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation.
