O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct state highway known as Bayshore Highway (Road IV-SCL-68-B) at grade across San Jose Branch of The Western Pacific Railroad Company near San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. <sup>45-16.1</sup>~~46-16.7~~. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, including installation of crossing protection, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines and maintenance of crossing protection. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two A.R.A. Flashing Light Signals conforming to the standards of the United States Bureau of Public Roads.

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Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
