In the Matter of the Application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to lay down, construct, operate and maintain a side track, at grade, across Front and J, First, Fourth and "L" Streets, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.) Application No. 22482.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Front and "J," First, Fourth and "L" Streets in San Diego, San Diego County, at the locations described in the application. None of the above named streets are now actually constructed and open to travel at the respective points of crossing and this Order is not an authorization for the construction of an opening of said streets to public use across said track. Said track shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding four per cent will be feasible in the event that the construction of an opening of the various streets across said track may hereafter be authorized and so that said grade crossings may be made suitable for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
