ORDER

Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Eighth Street and Sixteenth Street in the City and County of San Francisco, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2SG-1.56. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-A).

Applicant shall remove the tracks shown in yellow on the map attached to the application, in so far as they lie in Eighth Street and Sixteenth Street, and shall repair the roadway to conform to the remainder thereof.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
