ORDER

Interurban Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a cross-over track at grade between its two main lines on Bancroft Avenue at Victoria Court in San Leandro, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. G-15.27. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by the existing Standard No. 2 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-A).

Applicant shall, within ninety (90) days from the date of this order file with this Commission a certified copy of a resolution or permit from the City of San Leandro for the construction of these tracks and in the event that this is not done, the authorization herein granted shall become null and void unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended) or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
