BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Southern Pacific Company and its Lessee, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company for authority to (a) abandon the station of Dow, in the County of Kern, State of California, and (b) to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 943 feet in length located at said station.)

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Dow for more than two years; that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary; and that a spur track located at said station should be abandoned and removed.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company and its Lessee, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are authorized to abandon the non-agency station of Dow, County of Kern; to eliminate said name from station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove the spur track, approximately 943 feet in length located at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
