FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission on December 19, 1938 entered its order, Decision No. 31581, in the above entitled proceeding, permitting applicant to change its station of Vigorit from a Class "A" non-agency station to a Class "E" station, and to cancel all freight tariffs and time tables applying at said station.

It now appears from applicant's supplemental application, filed February 10, 1939, that no business has been transacted at said station of Vigorit during the past two years and its continuance as a station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Vigorit, County of Alameda, and to eliminate said name from its station records, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
