O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Tom for more than two years; that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary; and that a siding located at said station should be abandoned and removed.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Tom, County of Mono; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove a siding 744.2 feet in length, located at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
