SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER


Applicant herein has advised the Commission, in writing, that while the grade separation at Third Street and University Avenue, Berkeley, over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, as authorized by Decision No. 31706, dated January 30, 1939, is under construction, vehicular traffic will be detoured over the crossing at grade of Virginia Street (Crossing No. A-9.6) and that said crossing should be widened to the full width of the street and protected by automatic flashlight signals. Applicant has requested that such widening and protection be authorized and it appearing that the request is reasonable and should be granted

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED (1) that said crossing of Virginia Street be widened to the full width of the street to conform to existing improvements on either side thereof, at the sole expense of applicant, and (2) that two A. R. A. automatic flashlight signals be installed for the protection of highway traffic at the crossing at grade of Virginia Street over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company (Crossing No. A-9.6) at the sole expense of applicant, the maintenance of these signals thereafter being borne by Southern Pacific Company.

In all other respects Decisions Nos. 31706 and 31777 shall remain in full force and effect.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
