

Decision No. 31897

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company for authority (a) to abandon its non-agency station of Rose, County of Sonoma, State of California, and (b) abandon and remove the spur track approximately 533 feet in length located at said station.)

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Rose for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary; and that spur track approximately 533 feet in length located at said station should be abandoned and removed.

Good cause appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Rose, County of Sonoma; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove spur track approximately 533 feet in length located at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
