## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 30733 of March 28, 1938, in the above entitled application, S. W. Nelson was granted authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act to transport certain clay products from plants of Gladding McBean & Company located at Los Angeles, Santa Monica and Alberhill to points in southern and central California as far north as Bakersfield and San Luis Obispo, at less than the minimum rates established therefor in Case No. 4088. Parts "M" and "V". Provision was made that the authority so granted would expire April 17, 1939. By supplemental application filed April 7, 1939, applicant seeks an extension of that authority until the effective date of the minimum rates established by Decision No. 31606 in Case No. 4246, in re Rates of all Common and In support of the supplemental application it Highway Carriers. is stated that the latter decision makes substantial changes in the minimum rates from which applicant was authorized to deviate, but

Decision No. 31606 establishes minimum rates of statewide application which, upon their becoming effective, will cancel and supersede the minimum rates established in Case No. 4088, Parts "M" and "V", from which applicant originally was given relief.

that a continuance of the relief is necessary until such time as the new minimum rates become effective.

This does not appear to be a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. Parties who entered appearances in the hearing on the original application have been notified of the filing of the supplemental application and have offered no objection to the extension sought. The supplemental application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission, the expiration date of the authority granted to S. W. Nelson by Decision No. 30733 of March 28, 1938, in the above entitled application, be and it is hereby extended to the effective date of the minimum rates established by Decision No. 31606 of December 27, 1938, in Case No. 4246.
