SEVENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Petition having been filed by Armour & Company, The Cudany Packing Company, The Luer Packing Co., Swift & Company and Wilson & Company, seeking exclusion of live stock from the application of the minimum rates established by Decision No. 31473 of November 25, 1938, in the above entitled proceeding, for transportation within the Los Angeles drayage area, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraph (b), Rule No. 10, Appendix "A" of Decision No. 31473 of November 25, 1938, in the above entitled proceeding, be and it is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sub-paragraph:

"(11) Live Stock."

In all other respects said Decision No. 31473 shall remain in full force and effect.
