OPINION AND ORDER

In this application Pacific Greyhound Lines requests the Commission to issue its order amending the route of operations in the city of Pittsburg heretofore established by the Commission's Decision No. 24280, on Seventh Supplemental Application No. 16989.

Applicant alleges as a necessity for the requested change of routing that the location of its depot has been moved from 372 Railroad Avenue to Fifth Street and Railroad Avenue.

This does not appear to be a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and the authority sought will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the language appearing in the order of Decision No. 24280, at sheet 1 in the following words

"(the route within the City of Pittsburg being via Tenth Street, Black Diamond Street, Third Street, Railroad Avenue and Tenth Street)"

is hereby amended to read as follows:

(via Tenth Street to Railroad Avenue, to Fifth Street, to Black Diamond Street, to Tenth Street).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 24280 in all other respects, except as hereby amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
