O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Eaglet for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary and that a shelter shed and spur track located at said station should be abandoned and removed.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Eaglet, County of San Luis Obispo; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 795 feet in length, together with a frame shelter shed located at said station.

Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
