In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to (a) abandon its non-agency station of Tennyson, County of Alameda, State of California, and (b) to abandon and remove its shelter shed located at said station.) Application No. 22673

ORDER

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Tennyson for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary and that a shelter shed located at said station should be abandoned and removed.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Tennyson, County of Alameda; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove a frame shelter shed located at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
