ORDER

It appears from the above application that due to the installation, by the City of Los Angeles, of traffic signals at the intersection of Jasmine Avenue and Venice Boulevard, compliance with Section VI (d) of General Order No. 75-A will result in a conflict of signals (existing wigwag and the traffic signals), at the grade crossing of Jasmine Avenue with applicant's Venice Short Line (crossing No. 6V-9.85).

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is exempted from compliance with Section VI (d) of General Order No. 75-A at this location.

Within thirty days after completion of the signal installation as proposed, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
