SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application Ira P. Lamb, a highway contract carrier and a city carrier, was granted authority under Section 11 of the Highway Carriers' Act and Section 10 of the City Carriers' Act to charge other than the minimum rates established in Case No. 4121 and Case No. 4088 Part "F", for the transportation of grain, grain products and related commodities, under contract with Sperry Flour Company, between points within certain defined areas in southern California. The authority was granted for a temporary period expiring June 1, 1939. By supplemental application filed April 6, 1939, this carrier now seeks an indefinite extension of such authority. In support of the supplemental application, it is asserted that the conditions shown in support of the original application continue to exist to the same extent and in the same degree and manner; that the need for relief is as great now as at the time the original authority was granted; and that no new conditions have arisen to make unnecessary a continuation of that authority.

No one opposed the granting of the original application. It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that an extension of the authority is justified. However, this find-

ing is necessarily based on existing conditions and an indefinite extension would not be warranted. Accordingly, the authority will be extended at this time for a period of one year only.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 30938 of May 31, 1938, as amended, in the above entitled application be and it is hereby extended to June 1, 1940.

This order shall become effective June 1, 1939.
