BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Big Trees for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof, or its spur track and station platform thereat,, is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Big Trees, County of Santa Cruz; to abandon and remove its spur track, approximately 449 feet in length together with its station platform situated at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
