O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across "Y" Street in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. AU90.5-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. No. 75-A).

This order shall become null and void and of no further force and effect unless applicant shall file within ninety (90) days from the date hereof a certified copy of a permit or resolution from the City of Sacramento consenting to the construction of said crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
