BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On page 10 of Decision No. 31907 the following statement appears:

"That Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, file the rate schedules herein authorized and in a manner satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, and with such filing shall submit a map setting forth the special rate area herein authorized, together with a 'Preliminary Statement' suitably defining the boundary of such rate area."

Good cause appearing, the above statement is hereby amended to read as follows:

"That Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall, within one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of this Order, file the rate schedules herein authorized and in a manner satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, and with such filing shall submit a map setting forth the special rate area herein authorized, together with a 'Preliminary Statement' suitably defining the boundary of such rate area."

In all other respects Decision No. 31907 shall remain
in full force and effect.

This supplemental order shall be effective immediately.
