Decision No. 32300 BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, OPIGIMAL a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California, granting to applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct, operate and maintain, in portions of the Counties of Tehama, Glenn, and Colusa, the electric lines and facilities herein described; author-Application No. 22527 izing the construction and installation of said electric lines in accordance with so-called substanderd construction; and approving the establishment of a special rate area embracing the territory in which said electric lines are to be located. BY THE COMMISSION: SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER On page 10 of Decision No. 31907 the following statement appears: "That Pacific Gos and Electric Company shall, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, file the rate schedules herein authorized and in a manner satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, and with such filing shall submit a map setting forth the special rate area herein authorized, together with a 'Preliminary Statement' suitably defining the boundary of such rate area." Good cause appearing, the above statement is hereby amended to read as follows: "That Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall, within one hundred and twenty (120) days from the date of this Order, file the rate schedules herein authorized and in a manner satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, and with such filing shall submit a map setting forth the special rate area herein authorized, together with a 'Preliminary Statement' suitably defining the boundary of such rate area." -1In all other respects Decision No. 31907 shall remain in full force and effect.

This supplemental order shall be effective immediately.
