PENDING FINAL DECISION


By Decision No. 32056, dated June 6, 1939, the schedule of water rates theretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by the Associated Water Company was suspended for the period of one month from May 27, 1939, to June 27, 1939, and there was established a schedule of temporary rates to be effective during said period, which temporary schedule was set out in full as a part of the Order in the above mentioned decision. There has now been received a supplementary petition signed by the Associated Water Company and by H. S. Williams, representative for the committee of consumers of said Company, requesting the Railroad Commission to extend the time during which the temporary schedule of rates shall continue in effect in order to permit the two parties to complete the details of the

plan whereby it is contemplated that the Associated Water Company will transfer all or a portion of its water system to such person or corporation as may be designated by the consumers. It appearing proper that such an order should be issued, now therefore,

Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the temporary schedule of rates for water delivered by Associated Water Company as established for a period of one month by Decision No. 32056 shall continue in effect from the date of this Order until terminated, modified, or revised by subsequent Order of this Commission.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
