to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs
and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's
notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove a
spur track approximately 700 feet in length located at said station.

Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
