FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Supplemental application having been filed therefor and Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that conditions Nos. 2 and 3 of Decision No. 32015, dated May 23, 1939, be and they are hereby amended to read as follows:

2. Applicants J. A. Gritsch, Ernest A. Gritsch and Oregon-Nevada-California Fast Freight, Inc. shall, at least one (1) day prior to the beginning of operations by said Oregon-Nevada-California Fast Freight Inc., join in common supplement to the tariffs on file with this Commission covering service given by said J. A. Gritsch and said

Ernest A. Critsch, said J. A. Gritsch and said Ernest A. Critsch withdrawing and applicant Oregon-Nevada-Colifornia Fast Freight, Inc. accepting and establishing as its own, such tariffs and all effective supplements thereto.

3. Applicant Oregon-Nevada-California Fast Freight, Inc. shall at least one (1) day prior to beginning operations, file in duplicate in its own name, time schedules covering service heretofore given by applicant J. A. Gritsch and by applicant Ernest A. Critsch, which time schedules shall be identical with the time schedules now on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of said J. A. Gritsch and said Ernest A. Gritsch, or time schedules satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
