ORDER

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Simons for more than twelve months and that the continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Simons, County of Los Angeles; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
