FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL  
OPINION AND ORDER

The Commission by its Decision No. 31993, dated May 9, 1939, authorized Union Pacific Stage Company, a corporation, the applicant herein, to establish and operate its service authorized by Decision No. 22570, dated June 23, 1930, to and from the East Los Angeles Depot of Union Pacific Railroad Company, over and along Atlantic Avenue, between said depot and the intersection of Florence Avenue and Atlantic Avenue.

In this fifth supplemental application applicant alleges that the routing authorized by Decision No. 31993 is not a practical route over which to conduct the operations authorized by Decision No. 22570, as amended by Decision No. 26832, and requests authority to operate over Slauson Avenue, Gage Avenue and Atlantic Avenue, to provide service to and from its stations located at Huntington Park and Bell, in lieu of the route authorized by Decision No. 31993.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the route of operations as set forth in Decision No. 26832, dated February 26, 1934, is hereby

supplemented to provide that applicant may establish and operate its service as authorized by Decision No. 22570, dated June 23, 1930, between the East Los Angeles Depot of Union Pacific Railroad Company, on the one hand, and Huntington Park and Bell, on the other hand, over and along Atlantic Avenue, diverting to Huntington Park and Bell over Slauson Avenue and Gage Avenue, respectively, as an extension and enlargement of applicant's existing operative rights created by Decision No. 22570.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 31993, dated May 9, 1939, is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
