O R D E R

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct spur tracks at grade across 11th Street, 12th Street and Walnut Street in the City of Sanger, Fresno County, at the locations described in the application. Said crossings shall be identified as follows:

11th Street - a portion of Crossing No. BC-220.1
12th Street - Unused Street
Walnut Street - a portion of Crossing No. BC-220.2

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding 3 per cent. Protection at 11th and Walnut Streets shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign at each location (G. O. No. 75-A).

This order is made upon the express condition that 12th Street is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said street to public use across said track. Said track shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding 2 per cent will be feasible in the event that the construction of an opening of 12th Street across said track shall hereinafter be authorized and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order,

applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
