THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On page one of Decision No. 31762, dated February 14, 1939,
the following statement appears, which amends a similar paragraph
appearing in Decision No. 31665, dated January 16, 1939:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Diamond Match Company
be and it is hereby directed to file with the Railroad
Commission of the State of California within sixty (60)
days from the date of this Order, the schedule of rates
set forth in Exhibit 'A' (attached to the application)
to be charged for all electric service supplied to its
consumers, applicable to meter readings taken on and af-
ter the 1st day of April, 1939."

Good Cause Appearing, the above statement is hereby amended
as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Diamond Match Company
be and it is hereby directed to file with the Railroad
Commission of the State of California, within two hundred
and eighty-nine (289) days from the date of this Order,
the schedule of rates set forth in Exhibit 'A' (attached
to the application) to be charged for all electric service
supplied to its consumers, applicable to meter readings
taken on and after the 1st day of November, 1939."

In all other respects Decision No. 31665 shall remain in
full force and effect.

This supplemental order shall be effective immediately.
