ORDER

It appears from the above application that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Escalle for more than two years and that continued maintenance of freight service is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon freight service at its non-agency station of Escalle, County of Marin; to cancel all freight tariffs and freight time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove spur track approximately 509 feet in length, located at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
