BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

It appears from the above-numbered application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's stations of McCormick Siding, Jack's Siding, Quinn's Spur, and Quartz Junction, Tuolumne County, California, for more than one year and that the continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Sierra Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of McCormick Siding, Jack's Spur, Quinn's Spur, and Quartz Junction; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
