O P I N I O N

By his application, R. Miller, operating under the fictitious name and style of Martinez-Diablo Stage, seeks an amendment to his certificate of public convenience and necessity for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express, between Martinez and Walnut Creek and intermediate points, which will provide that in the transportation of express no single shipment in excess of one hundred (100) pounds need be transported.

As justification for the granting of the authority herein sought, applicant alleges that no shipments in excess of one hundred (100) pounds have been tendered to him in many years. He further alleges that, due to the type of equipment in use on his lines, he is not in a position to transport shipments in excess of the weight above referred to.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 24650, dated April 4, 1932, on Application No. 17959, be, and it is hereby, amended to

provide that,


In the transportation of express no single shipment in excess of one hundred (100) pounds shall be transported and all express matter shall be carried on passenger vehicles only,


subject to the condition that applicant shall file, in triplicate, on at least five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, a supplement to his tariff in conformity with the authority herein granted.


The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.


