In the Matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California granting and conferring upon applicant all necessary permission and authority to publish and establish, effective July 1, 1939, the schedules of electric rates and charges referred to herein, and to withdraw and cancel as of July 1, 1939 the within mentioned schedules of electric rates and charges of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation and Midland Counties Public Service Corporation.

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 32261 in the First Supplemental Order in Application No. 22825, paragraph 2 of said Order authorized Pacific Gas and Electric Company to file and establish certain electric rate schedules, including a Preliminary Statement, and all as set forth in Exhibit A-1 attached to the Supplemental Application.

By Advice No. 253 the Applicant Utility has submitted such a schedule of rates and a Preliminary Statement, but in said Advice attention is called to three minor changes which have been incorporated, which make the aforesaid rate schedules and Preliminary Statement different than originally set forth in Exhibit A-1. Two of these changes relate to the description of the service area as set forth in the Preliminary Statement for Ambrose and East Salinas and the third change lowers, by one (1) mill, a particular rate contained in Schedule C-5.

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is hereby authorized to file those schedules of rates and Preliminary Statement as submitted with its Advice No. 253.
