## ORDER OF REVOCATION AND DISMISSAL

On June 16,1939, applicants herein filed an application requesting the sale and transfer of the operative rights of Union Pacific Stages of California to Interstate Transit Lines. On July 18,1939, the Commission, by its Decision No. 32170, as supplemented by its Decision No. 32256, dated August 15,1939, granted the authority requested by applicants as prayed for.

In this supplemental application, applicants allege that the exact nature of the transaction whereby applicant Union Pacific Stages of California proposed to transfer its intrastate operative rights to Interstate Transit Lines was not fully set forth in the application requesting the transfer. Accordingly, applicants desire a dismissal of the above-entitled application and the vacation of the above-numbered decision of the Commission, without prejudice to the rights of applicants to file a new and separate application fully setting forth the nature of the proposed transfer and the terms and conditions upon which the same will be accomplished.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 32170, dated July 18, 1939 and Decision No. 32256, dated August 15, 1939, are hereby vacated, revoked and annulled, and Application No. 22811 is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
