O R D E R

County of San Luis Obispo is authorized to construct temporary grade crossing at Dolores Avenue across Coast Line of Southern Pacific Company at Atascadero, San Luis Obispo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-226.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction and removal expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-five feet and grades of approach not greater than 6 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.C. 72. Protection shall be by 2 Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.C. 75-B).

Authority granted by this decision is strictly temporary and shall apply only during the replacement period of bridge over Atascadero Creek at the River Garden Section in the town of Atascadero, said period not to exceed one year.

Upon completion of said bridge, Crossing No. E-226.0 shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion of temporary crossing pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing and within thirty days after removal of temporary crossing, applicant shall likewise advise the Commission. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
