Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Roche, County of Tulare; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public; and to abandon and remove spur track approximately 843 feet in length located at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment and removal applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
