

Decision No. 22937.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of the City of Placerville existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of California, for permission to construct a public road across Union Street between Clay Street and Bedford Street across Southern Pacific Railroad tracks in the City of Placerville.

ORIGINAL

Application No. 22937.

O R D E R

City of Placerville is authorized to construct road between Bedford Avenue and Clay Street across Placerville Branch of Southern Pacific Company at Placerville, Eldorado County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. AH-149.2. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 20 feet and grades of approach not greater than 4 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by 1 Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O.75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
