FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

To correct an obvious error in Decision No. 32303,
dated September 12, 1939,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the preamble to the order
therein, which reads

"Pacific Gas and Electric Company applies
for authority to exercise an electric fran-
chise granted by the City of Turlock,
Stanislaus County. A public hearing upon
the application has been held. Such fran-
chise is one authorized by the Franchise
Act of 1937, and is in lieu of certain
asserted franchises under which applicant
for many years has rendered electric service
within the City and surrounding territory.
It is evident that the requested authority
should be given."

be and hereby is amended to read:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company applies
for authority to exercise a gas franchise
granted by the City of Turlock, Stanislaus
County. A public hearing upon the applica-
tion has been held. Such franchise is one
authorized by the Franchise Act of 1937, and
is in lieu of certain asserted franchises
under which applicant for many years has
rendered gas service within the City and
surrounding territory. It is evident that
the requested authority should be given.

In all other respects the language of Decision
No. 32303 remains unchanged.
