BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California, granting to applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the right, privilege and franchise heretofore granted to applicant's predecessor in interest San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation by Ordinance No. 313 of the City Council of the CITY OF SELMA, County of Fresno, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company applies for authority to exercise an electric franchise granted by the City of Selma, Fresno County. A public hearing upon the application has been held. Such franchise is one authorized by the Franchise Act of 1937. Applicant and its predecessors for many years have rendered electric service within the City of Selma, and it is evident that the requested authority should be given.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and hereby is granted to Pacific Gas

and Electric Company to exercise the right or privilege under that certain franchise granted by the City of Selma by Ordinance No. 313 of June 6, 1938, subject to the condition, however, that no claim of value for such franchise or the authority hereby granted, in excess of the actual cost thereof, shall ever be made by the grantee before this Commission or before any court or other public body.
