

Decision No. 22883

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California authorizing it to enter into a certain agreement with DWIGHT E. BROWN in words and figures as written in the form therefor which is annexed hereto.

ORDER

In this application Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, asks for authority to enter into an agreement with Dwight E. Brown, an irrigator, providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to said Dwight E. Brown of water from its Lower Greeley Canal, not to exceed a flow of two (2) miners inches⁽¹⁾ for the irrigation of a portion of Brown's 22 acres located in the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and a fraction of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, Township 11 North, Range 8 East, MDB&M, in Placer County, said water to be paid for at the rate of 16¢ per miners inch day.⁽²⁾

Inasmuch as both parties are agreeable to the signing of the proposed agreement and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company,

(1) A miners inch for the purpose hereof shall mean a continuous flow of water equivalent to 1.5 cubic feet per minute.

(2) A miners inch day shall mean one miners inch as heretofore defined flowing for a period of twenty-four hours.

a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the sale and delivery of water to Dwight E. Brown under substantially the same terms and conditions as set forth in the form agreement marked Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1 which is attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within sixty (60) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
