Southern Pacific Company having, on August 18th, 1939, requested in writing that Decision No. 32180, dated July 18th, 1939. in the instant proceeding, be modified and it appearing that a public hearing is not necessary and that said request should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first paragraph of the above-numbered decision is hereby amended to read as follows:

Southern Facific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grado across an unnamed alley at Fashion Avenue, in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense. The unnamed alley is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and this order is not an authorization for the construction of opening of said alley to public use across said track. Sgid track shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding two per cent will be feasible, in the event that the construction of opening of the alley across said track shall hereafter be authorized and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

In all other respects, Decision No. 32180 shall remain
