O P I N I O N

In this proceeding, Bridge Bus Lines Corporation asks the Commission to require defendant Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc. to cease and desist serving the San Anselmo and Corte Madera territory in Marin County.

A public hearing in this matter was held before former Commissioner Ware on September 15, 1937, in San Francisco, at which time the matter was submitted.

Although the parties to this proceeding were notified of this hearing, the only appearance entered was that of defendant. Representatives of complainant were contacted by the Commission, and it was advised that complainant had concluded not to put in an appearance or offer any evidence and, furthermore, would have no objection to the matter being dismissed. Defendant then moved that the matter be dismissed.

Accordingly, the matter should be dismissed.

ORDER

A public hearing having been held and the matter being duly submitted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Case No. 4228 is hereby dismissed.
