BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, a corporation, for an order of the Railroad Commission authorizing applicant to grant to the CITY OF LODI, a municipal corporation, a certain right of way, herein particularly described, and to execute a grant in the form therefor annexed hereto.

BY THE COMMISSION:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company applies for authority to grant to the City of Lodi a right of way across a narrow strip of land lying along the east side of South Sacramento Street and being the westerly portion of the parcel of land upon which Applicant's gas holder and other facilities are located.

The widening of Sacramento Street is a definite municipal program and it is evident that the requested authority, which will not adversely affect Applicant's utility operations, should be given. A public hearing upon this application does not appear necessary.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and is hereby authorized to grant to the City of Lodi on or before December 31, 1939, a right of way across that certain parcel of land described in Exhibit "A" and delineated upon the map designated Exhibit "B" of this application, said trans-

action to be accomplished by executing and delivering to the City of Lodi of a grant substantially in the form of Exhibit "A" aforesaid.

The authority hereby given is subject to the condition that within thirty (30) days after the execution of this grant Applicant shall file a copy thereof with this Commission.
