BY THE COMMISSION:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company applies for authority to exercise a gas franchise granted by the City of South San Francisco, County of San Mateo. This franchise is one authorized by the Franchise Act of 1937, and is in lieu of certain asserted franchises under which Applicant or its predecessors for many years has rendered gas service within the City of South San Francisco. Public hearings upon the application have been held and it is evident that the requested authority should be given.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and hereby is granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to exercise the right or privilege under that certain franchise granted by the City of South San Francisco by Ordinance No. 197 of August 29, 1938, subject to

the condition, however, that no claim of value for such franchise or for the authority hereby granted, in excess of the actual cost thereof, shall ever be made by the grantee before this Commission or before any court or other public body,
