Decision No. 32434

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of ANDREW H. IVERSEN, for authority to discontinue operation of an automobile service as a common carrier between Paso Robles and Annette.

BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION

In this application Andrew H. Iversen requests the authority of the Railroad Commission to discontinue and abandon his automotive service for the transportation of passengers and property between Paso Robles and Annette and intermediate points.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that the revenue derived from such operation is insufficient to warrant his continued operation.

The operative right involved was created by decision No. 27563,

dated December 3, 1934, on Application No. 19714.

This is not a matter requiring a public hearing and we are of the opinion that the authority sought is in the public interest and it will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Andrew H. Iversen is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon the transportation of passengers and property between Paso Robles and Annette and intermediate points.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operative right therefor, heretofore created by the Commission's Decision No. 27563, dated December 3, 1934, on Application No. 19714, is hereby revoked and annualled.

IT IS FURTHER OFDERED that all tariffs and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of Andrew H.

Iversen are hereby cancelled.
