O P I N I O N

In this application Mae A. Spreitz, doing business as Spreitz Transportation, requests authority to abandon the transportation of shipments of express weighing in excess of one hundred pounds between Goleta and Carpinteria and intermediate points, via Santa Barbara, and for a revocation of the operative right therefor.

The right involved was created by the Commission's Decision No. 20819, dated February 25, 1929, on Application No. 14564, and acquired by applicant under the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 27401, dated September 29, 1934, on Application No. 19586. The decision creating this operative right authorized the transportation of passengers, baggage and express packages weighing not in excess of one hundred pounds each.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that there is no demand for the transportation of any shipments of express weighing in excess of one hundred pounds.

This is not a matter requiring a public hearing and we are of the opinion that the request is in the public interest and it will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Mae A. Spreitz, doing business as Spreitz Transportation, is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon the transportation of shipments of express weighing in excess of one hundred pounds between Goleta and Carpinteria and intermediate points and the operative right therefor, heretofore created by Decision No. 20819, dated February 25, 1929, is hereby revoked and annulled.

This order is subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall publish and file in her tariff within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof, and on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, a cancellation of the rates for the service herein authorized to be discontinued and abandoned.
2. Applicant shall transport no shipments of express weighing in excess of one hundred (100) pounds and no shipments may be transported except on passenger carrying vehicles.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
