## FIRST SUPPIFMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 31611 oi December 26, 1938, in the above entitied application, Joaquin Iopez, an indivinul operating as a city camper and a highrey contract carrier, was anthorized to transyort paper, paper articies ana related comoaities for varfous shippers in the Los Angeles drayage area at losser charges tinn those accruing under the estabiched minimum rates. This antionity will expire on October 31, 1939. By supplemental appifation tinis carmiez now seeks an extension of the authority for an inderinitc poriod. It alleges that the conditions existing at the time the original application was granted continuc to exist at the present time rithout material change.

It appears from the application that an extencion of the authority heretofore granted is justificed and that such extersion may be authorized Fithout the necessity of a fomal hearing. Zy Decision No. 32504 in Case No. 4121, issued on 0ctober 24, 1939, homever, rates substantiaily the same as tiose which appicant was previoutiy authorized to charge berein were proviced for transportation within the Ios Angeles drayage area by carriers generaliy. This adjustment Will become effective January 1,1940 , and the extemsion of the actionity herein Mill be Ifmited, thereione, to December 3I, 1939. Therefore, good cause appearing,
