all liabilities of said Downey Home Tele-
phone & Telegraph Company existing at the
date of such acquisition; (e) authorizing
Consolidated Telephone Company to enter
and engage in the telephone business in the
territory now served by Downey Home Tele-
phone & Telegraph Company.


